#### ---- PARADE INFORMATION -----

#### **Parade Floats & Entries**

- All Parade entries are requested to comply with the 2021 Parade Theme "Home for the Holidays." PLEASE – NO LIVE SANTAS!
- Floats should be no more than 15' high and 30' long.
- The "title" of the Float needs to be indicated on the Entry Form along with the number of people riding on the Float & the number of people with float, animals, music, etc.
- Nonprofit community organizations that enter a Float may apply to receive a \$100 cost deferral award (see pg. 2).
- Float judging begins promptly at 4:30 pm. "Non-Profit" there will be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners.
  - "For Profit" businesses you will be competing for the Santa's Cup.
- NOTE: Parade entries may be limited to comply with the most current health orders.

#### Parade Line-up

- Line-up details will be sent to you by Wednesday, December 1st via email.
- Parade line-up starts at 4:30 pm. Refer to the office emails for further instructions. Floats must be in the line-up no later than 4:30 pm to be included in the float judging. Your pulling vehicle may or may not be permitted to stay with the float, depending on available space.
- All other units should be in the line-up by 4:50 pm. Be sure to look for your assigned space number (sent to you ahead of time). Non-parade vehicles will not be permitted on Thibault Ln.

### For the safety of all Parade participants and observers:

- Participants must remain in the designated Parade space throughout the entire Parade
- Participants are NOT allowed to approach vehicles as they drive through Thibault Ln
- Participants MUST adhere to the most up-to-date health orders...you may be asked to leave if you refuse

# Recognition

"For Non-Profit" Parade floats that are in their assigned Line-up spot by 4:30 pm will be judged and recognition given to the entries voted 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place. Float judging will be based on parade theme harmony, originality, artistic quality, and music. All decisions of the Parade float judges are final.

## Santa's Cup Competition

"For Profit" businesses' Parade floats that are in their assigned line-up spot by 4:30 pm will be judged and the Santa Cup awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> Place. Float judging will be based on parade theme harmony, originality, artistic quality, and music. All decisions of the Parade float judges are final.

## **Cost Deferral Awards**

Parade float entries submitted by non-profit community organizations may be eligible to receive a \$100 cost deferral award. The awards will be issued to the first three (3) eligible entries received. Additional awards may be issued based on available funding. Eligibility will be determined by the Saline Winter Parade Committee. All decisions of the Committee are final.

To be eligible to receive a Cost Deferral Award:

- Entry must be a non-profit community organization
- Organization <u>must submit the completed request below along with entry form</u>
- Entry form must be received by November 23rd at 9 am (no exceptions)
- Entry must be approved for Parade participation
- Float must be in assigned Parade Line-up spot by 4:30 pm for Float judging
- Float must have significant decorations that fit the Parade's theme
- Float participants must follow all Parade participation rules as stated on the entry form
- Non- Profit Organizations must submit <u>receipts</u> to the Saline Chamber for materials used on their Float by December 15, 2021.
